Walk from the school down to Carlton
Road to a place which has sold sweets for 100
years.



From the corner stores cross
to the war ~~stores~~ memorial



Look across at a pub which is
named after 3 birds from a knight's
shield.



From here, visit All Saints church.
can you spot the water spouts with curved
faces.



Walk back to the war memorial past
Burdley's Butchers and cross safely to the
other side of the High St.

Go to the bridge and stand so
you can see the old mill.



Walk back to the three fishies pub. Landlords
have brewed their own beer from the stream for
hundreds of years.



walk back along the
high street to find
an old water
pump.



Turn up newton lane. can you
find an old well? locals were on
the news saying it was better
than mains water.



Cross over to look for a
cottage where an old craft was
practised to make something for
clothing and decor.



take the ~~short~~ path through the
meadow to JACK'S Lane.
walk back towards the High Street.
